An 8 ft table and two(2) chairs are provided at each booth. Only handmade finished art and craft items are to be sold. No buy/sell, factory, imported, mass produced; wholesale or readymade items may be sold. No raffles.

Set up time for booths will be Friday, November 4, 3:00 PM - 8:00 PM and Saturday, November 5, 7:00AM -8:30AM. Information booths will be open during set up times. Nothing may be attached to the walls. Extension cords will <u>not</u> be provided; please supply your own along with tape to secure the cords. Crafters agree to have someone operating their booth at all times. The booth shall remain open for business from 9:00 AM-4:00 PM and will NOT begin tearing down until 4:00 PM. Once the fair is over vacating the building by 6:00 PM is greatly appreciated. NO SMOKING in the building. Concessions will be available.

Crafters agree to assume full responsibility for loss or damage to their person or works. Reporting of sales tax collected will be the responsibility of the crafters.

Crafters who have not exhibited with us before agree to submit a photo(s) of their work with the **contract/application.** The photo(s) will not be returned.
