She held the county position for $9 \frac{1}{2}$ yrs. In 1855, there were 33 counties in Kansas. In 1858, the Register of Deeds was established. Prior to USDs, school records were also kept. Books, paper, microfilm and digital records are stored. Digital records started in the 1970s & total 2.4 million images. Veterans can record their DD-214 discharge record there for free. Four staff are located in the county courthouse. Back up data systems are located in Iowa and New Jersey. In 9 years, there have been 5 property fraud investigations.
