purchase. Final contract will be prepared.


<u>Program</u>: Terry Stahl, retired middle school teacher and author

The book title is "One Kansas Family, Stitched Together with Memories." The book was researched for several years to capture and preserve stories about the Hubbard family. Her dad, Joe Hubbard, remembered he was hunting on the day of the Pearl Harbor attack by the Japanese. His attempt to volunteer in the Army in January, 1942 was rejected due to a heart murmur. He was drafted 3 months later as a Limited Service man. He worked as a mechanic on B-17 and B-24 bombers. He was one of 55,000 enlisted men who were discharged after 14 months. He retired after working at the supply depot at Forbes AFB, Topeka.

Terry worked at the Topeka Youth Center correctional facility for 6 years and then was a Seaman teacher for 22 years. Her book is a self-published product printed and available on Amazon for \$22.50 plus tax & shipping.
