Civil War veterans came to Kansas after the war to settle the huge area of available land. Rocky has 4 great grandfathers who fought in the Civil War. In 1866, the Grand Army of the Republic (GAR) was formed to care for veterans and their widows and children. There were parades and flowers placed on graves on Memorial Day.
