The restoration effort received a \$5 million state of Kansas tourism grant for infrastructure improvements. Another \$25 million is needed to complete the project. Lighting and sound system design work is nearly completed. Senne company is leading infrastructure work. When completed, the theatre capacity will increase from 299 guests to 1,300 standing and 800 seating. Comedy, movies, concerts, receptions & community events are planned. Other restored theatres have been a major tourist destination. The building will be 100 yrs old in 2027. Jeff previously purchased the Thatcher Building, 112 SE 8th street, which has a restaurant. The top floor can be designed for loft apartments.
