Program: Barry Feaker, Topeka Rescue Mission

He is a Topeka West high school grad and played offensive tackle in college football. He's married for 45 years and was Director at Topeka Rescue Mission(TRM) for 36 years, 1986-2021. **During COVID, TRM switched to** community outreach and reduced its 300 nightly homeless population by 50%. It had to prioritize emergency housing for those with a Topeka connection only. In 2020, TRM assisted 160 persons to acquire stable housing. TRM also expanded food distribution with 500 volunteers to 18 counties and served 110,000. In 2921, the mobile service unit brought a group of services and served 700 unsheltered persons. The homeless population has increased in age from 30 yrs old in 1990 to 60 yrs old in 2020. TRM will shift to a compassion strategy which emphasizes connections with others.
